# 1. Redevelopment and Urban Development

Sumitomo Realty & Development Co., Ltd. (the "Company") regards "Land Innovation," in which multiple small parcels of land are consolidated into a larger scale, as its greatest strength, and has accumulated a variety of achievements with the redevelopment business, focusing on central Tokyo. Most importantly, the Company focuses on urban redevelopment under the Urban Renewal Act, which involves achieving an agreement with landowners and consultation with authorities. These redevelopment projects contribute to the formation of sustainable regions and communities by enhancing the liveliness of cities and developing the infrastructure through a high-level usage of land.

#### **Details of Major Contributions**

- Development of the city's infrastructure, which contributed to the strengthening of disaster prevention functions and increased convenience of public transportation
  - By widening narrow roads, it became possible for emergency vehicles to pass through and realized the separation of pedestrians and vehicles
  - Developing open spaces for facilitating community building and serving as disaster-prevention bases, which tend to be insufficient in urban areas
  - Realizing easy access by developing concourses to subway stations through redevelopment
- Revitalization and strengthening the sustainability of the city through mixed-use development and activities rooted in the region
  - Creating a lively city that benefits from a stream of people by bringing diversity through simultaneous development of office buildings, commercial facilities, homes, etc.
  - Conducting emergency drills in cooperation with police and fire departments and the local government to strengthen regional cooperation in response to disasters

















# 2. Office Buildings and Condominiums

The Company constantly provides comfortable spaces that align with the changes in peoples' working and living styles with the office building leasing business, which is number one in Tokyo with over 220 buildings, and the condominium sales business, which has supplied the highest number of units throughout the metropolitan area and Japan over the past five years. In facility planning, constructing buildings that are resistant to disasters to protect peoples' lives and safety, and consciousness toward the global environment are seen as important. The Company will work toward the formation of highly sustainable community assets through the development of office buildings and condominiums, which are important foundations for corporate activities and in the lives of people.

#### **Details of Major Contributions**

- Construction of buildings with structures and equipment that are resistant to disasters
  - Active introduction of seismic isolation/vibration control structures, and emergency power generators

# 3. Remodeling-Shinchiku Sokkurisan

The Company's remodeling business "Shinchiku Sokkurisan," based on the concept of safe and secure housing, takes pride in having the industry's foremost track record for the full remodeling of houses with seismic reinforcement as a part of the standard package. The cumulative total of units contracted reached 130,000 units (as of December 2018) by constantly proposing home remodeling in correspondence with the lifestyles of individual households, and using the Company's unique model of using a clear fixed-price system and a dedicated sales engineer, which has been widely accepted by customers.

The lives of houses in Japan are typically much shorter than those of houses in Europe and the U.S., and from the viewpoint of effective utilization of limited resources, "Shinchiku Sokkurisan" fulfills an important role as remodeling greatly reduces waste compared with rebuilding. Through "Shinchiku Sokkurisan," the Company provides highly sustainable houses in which people can comfortably live for a longer period of time.
