The Sumitomo Group has been preparing steadily for our “Sumitomo Pavilion” exhibition at EXPO 2025 Osaka, Kansai.

This pavilion exhibition will address social issues through the collective strength of the Sumitomo Group and the wisdom, technology, and human talent built throughout the years. We will create a place of gathering that moves people’s hearts and spurs change through exhibitions that create hope for the future and entertainment that inspires.



More than 1000 “Trees of the Sumitomo Forest” Featured on Roof and Façade

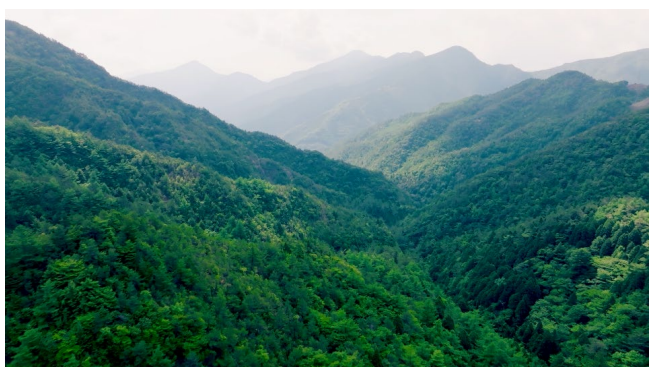
Trees were planted by our predecessors in the “Sumitomo Forest” owned by the Sumitomo Group. The “Sumitomo Pavilion” will create a place that provides the warmth and comfort of trees based on our desire to “respect the life of each tree without waste” and using them as wood resource in its entirety.



Trees planted at the 1970 Osaka EXPO also “transcend time in a full circle, returning as the Sumitomo Pavilion.”



The façade near the building’s entrance features “Japanese Cedar from the Sumitomo Forest” planted in 1970, the year of the Osaka EXPO. The trees, layered over one another, expresses the “rings of trees and geological layers of the land.”



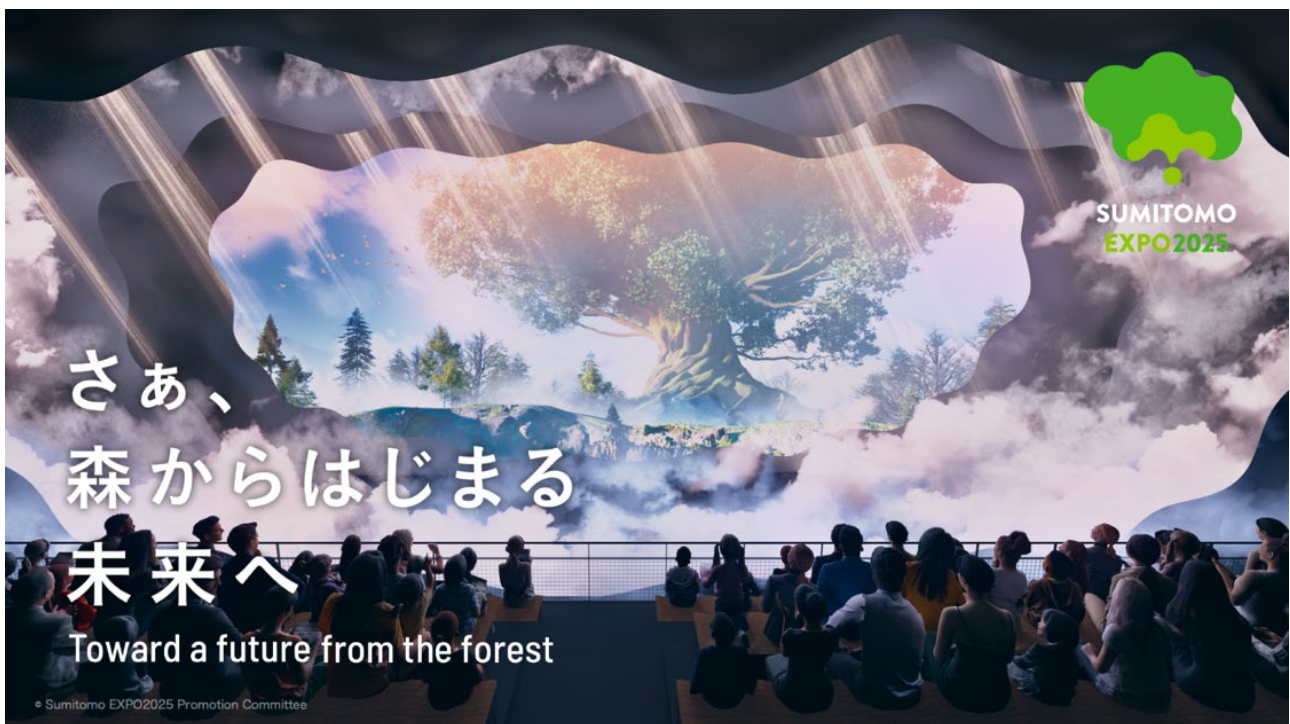
Inspired by the “peaks of the Besshi mountains” in Shikoku, which is the foundation of Sumitomo’s growth, the roof and façade features a silhouette of its mountaintops, created by plywood made from “Japanese Cypress of the Sumitomo Forest.”

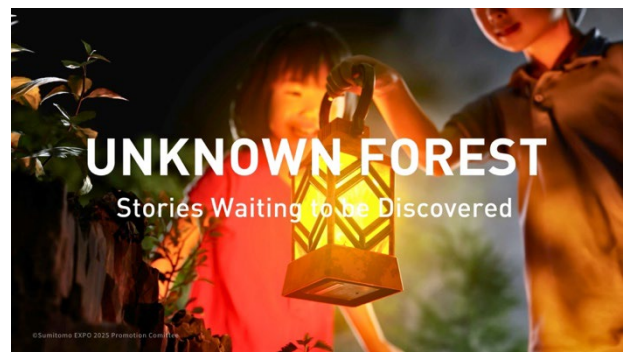
The Sumitomo Pavilion has announced two experiences. The first is the “UNKNOWN FOREST, Stories Waiting to be Discovered”, an interactive experience exploring a unique forest only found here. The second is a “PLANT A TREE” event, a program where visitors can touch seedlings and soil with their sights set on the future beyond 2025.



The Highlight of the Sumitomo Pavilion! “UNKNOWN FOREST”

◆“UNKNOWN FOREST, Stories Waiting to be Discovered”

Through its long-lasting relationship with the forest, Sumitomo has sought out the diverse arrays of values that it has to offer. This is a place where you see and hear things unnoticed to now, tell the story of life, and experience it. Inside this unique forest with teachings unknown to man, visitors will walk with lantern in hand and experience an interactive walk of light and sound to discover different stories of life and the UNKNOWN.

◆UNKNOWN FOREST “Performing Theater”

After the forest experience, visitors will be greeted by a “performing theater” approximately 20m wide x 7.5m high. The wind and fog will in the space will speak to the visitors’ senses and the dynamic production that fuses the multi-layered screen with music and people, will lead to the grand finale of the UNKNOWN FOREST.



“Performing Theater” 20m wide x 7.5m high, featuring wind and fog

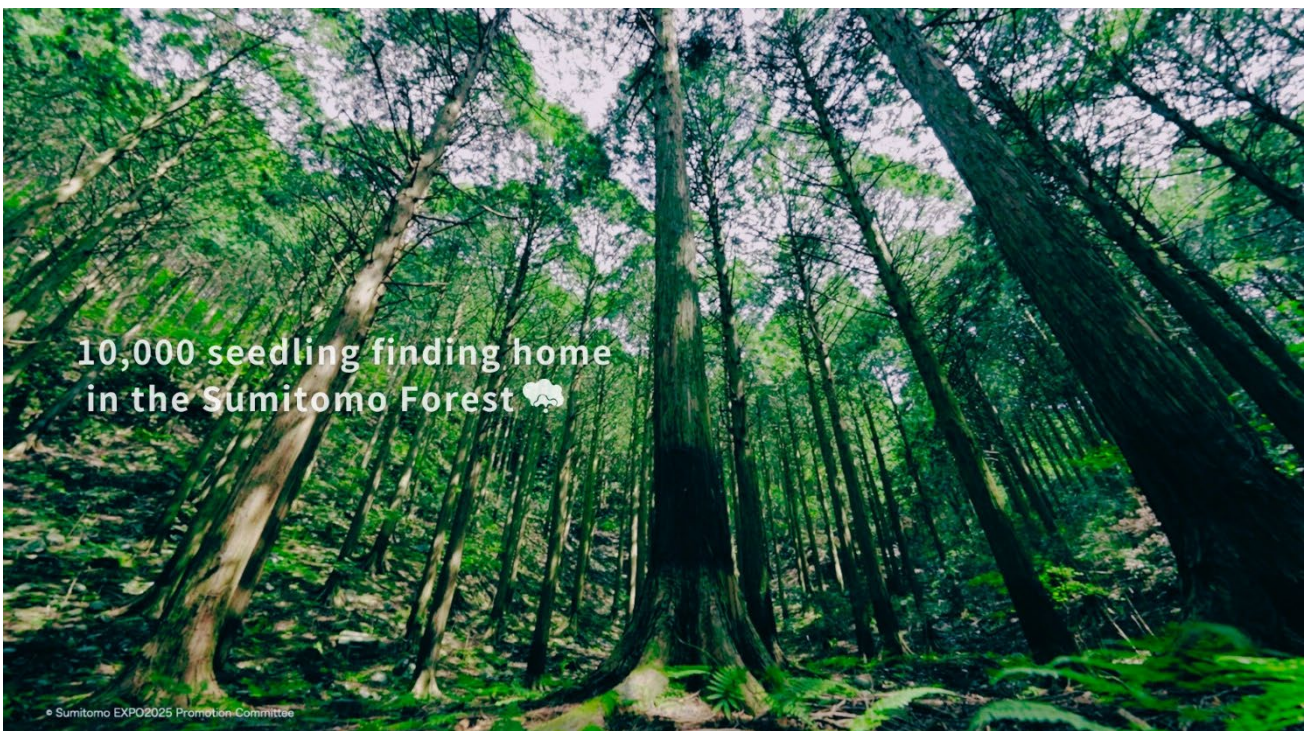


Imagery projected on a multi-layered screen will fuse with music and people to create a fantastical and extraordinary show

Approximately 10,000 seedlings for “PLANT A TREE” event during the EXPO

◆ 「PLANT A TREE」

The “PLANT A TREE” event welcomes all visitors for 2025 and the future. Approximately 10,000 seedlings will be procured throughout the EXPO in a program where visitors can come in touch with the seedling and the earth. These seedlings will be transplanted to the “Sumitomo Forest”, including the areas where trees have been logged for the construction of the Sumitomo Pavilion, and will be passed down centuries into the future.



Through tree planting, we will create an opportunity for people to learn about the relationship between forest and man, the importance of a circular forest, and build on that experience to address forest and nature while continuing to be reminded of the importance of thinking to the future.



Creator Collaborations

The Sumitomo Pavilion has plans to collaborate with creators from different walks of life. Uniforms of the Sumitomo Pavilion staff is one of the collaborations already announced for the UNKNOWN FOREST and we look forward to new announcements coming in the time leading up to the April 13, 2025 opening.
